When your employees get too much sun, you get burned !

Your employee's dark tan following his vacation might not seem like a problem. However, sun exposure is the cause of more than 90 percent of all skin cancer cases, and by the age of 65, 40 to 50 percent of Americans will have skin cancer at least once.

The National Business Group on Health estimates that American employers spend more than \$1.7 billion on skin cancer each year.

Encourage your employees to be sun smart this summer, with the following tips: Stay inside or in the shade between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m., when ultraviolet rays are the strongest and most damaging.

Wear sunscreen that offers both UVA and UVB protection, with a sun protection factor (SPF) of 15 or higher every time you go outside. Apply it liberally at least 30 minutes before going outside to allow it time to soak into your skin .

Reapply sunscreen at least every two hours, and whenever you have perspired heavily, gone swimming, or dried off with a towel – even if your sunscreen is water-resistant.

Wear protective clothing, including a

wide-brimmed hat and wrap-around sunglasses that block as close to 100 percent of both UVA and UVB rays as possible.

Be aware of any medications you're taking that cause sensitivity to the sun – many common medications, as well as cosmetics containing alpha hydroxy acids, can increase sun sensitivity and the likelihood of being burned.

Although skin cancer often can be removed through surgery when it's detected early, prevention is definitely the best strategy. Find free resources for educating your employees about skin cancer, including posters, articles, and fun facts, at www.anthem.com/timewellspent/cancer.
