While on the Board he has served as representative to other Boards such as the Licking County Planning Commission, Licking County Health Department, West Licking Joint Fire District, and the Licking County Township Trustees Association. He also served as Vice President of the Governor's Advisory Board under former Governor Richard F. Celeste. Mr. Carlisle owns and operates Carlisle Mechanical Contractors. He graduated from Father Wehrle High School in 1975 and has lived within Etna Township for over thirty years while raising 5 children and 8 grandchildren.

Chris Harkness has served as Zoning Administrator of Etna Township for the last three years. He is involved in the areas of zoning, land use planning, economic development, and grants. He is the township's representative on the Mid Ohio Regional Planning Commission and Etna Township Economic Development Committee as well as staff to various township boards such as the Township Trustees, Board of Zoning Appeals, Zoning Commission, Comprehensive Planning Committee, and the Etna Transportation Task Force. Chris came to the township from a land use planning background after working in the Planning Department of the City of Dayton, OH and earning a degree from Miami University in Urban and Regional Planning."
